Slobodkin Violins Trade Up Policy

You may trade in instruments and bows purchased from Slobodkin Violins and receive a store credit for the original purchase price subject to the following conditions:

1. The instrument or bow must be in good condition. Deductions will be made for any damage other than minor nicks and scratches or varnish wear resulting from normal use.
2. The value of the merchandise toward which you are trading must be at least \$200.00 greater than the merchandise you are returning.
3. If the value of the merchandise toward which you are trading is not at least \$200.00 greater than the value of your return then \$200.00 will be deducted from the price of your return and you will receive store credit for the balance of the original purchase price.
4. Bows valued at less than \$200.00 may not be accepted for trade if the reconditioning costs would exceed their value.
5. Trade-ins can be applied to other instruments or bows only.
6. Please keep a copy of your sales receipt. In the absence of other documentation the records of Slobodkin Violins will be used as the basis for trades under this agreement.
7. Instruments purchased from consigned inventory can be returned for consignment only.
